Dear Clients, Families, and Caregivers,

The Arc of San Diego's center-based locations will be closed until Governor Newsom's Shelter-in-Place Order has been lifted.

As an essential service provider, other programs are not affected by the center-based closures and remain open. Our Employment, Residential, and Community Living Services continue operating and providing critical support to individuals with disabilities.

We currently do not have a specific date as to when our centers will be re-opened. We are prepared to re-open and resume services as soon as public health officials have lifted the current order.
