Guidance for the Use of Face Masks

The purpose of this addendum is to communicate to clients, care providers and Arc staff the updated guidance on the use of face masks while on-site at an Arc location or in the community. Current Health Screenings, Social Distancing, Disinfection Measures and Isolation Protocols remain in effect.

Masks continue to be an important layer of protection in the transmission of the COVID-19 virus. The Arc strongly encourages staff and clients to continue to wear masks to protect against COVID-19. Masks will continue to be made available to staff and clients by The Arc of San Diego.

At Arc Locations

When staff enter any Arc-owned property (Centers and Group Homes) they are required at all times to wear a well fitted surgical mask or a higher filtration mask such Kn95 and N95. Clients are strongly encouraged but not required to wear a mask.

In The Community

While staff and clients are in the community, masks are no longer required, but are strongly recommended as an important layer of protection. This is for all persons regardless of vaccine status, for services provided outdoors, in indoor public settings, or on public transportation.

Arc Owned Vehicles or Staff Vehicles

Staff must wear a well fitted surgical mask or a higher filtration mask such Kn95 and N95 when they are in Arc-owned or private/staff vehicles with other occupants.
